
Jackie Robinson

"Jackie" Robinson was the first African-American baseball player to play in Major League Baseball since the game was segregated in the 1890's. Robinson broke the baseball color barrier as a 28-year old, when the Brooklyn Dodgers started him at first base on April 15, 1947.


The example of Robinson's character and talent challenged segregation and contributed significantly to the Civil Rights Movement. Jackie played Major League Baseball for ten years. Like many athletes at the time, Jackie was in the military during World War Two. The war and the segregation of baseball kept Jackie out of the major leagues until he was 28 years old. Robinson was inducted into baseball's Hall of Fame in 1962. Jackie's story has been turned into a major motion picture: "42". In this activity we look at Jackie's total career hits and speculate on how many hits Jackie would have had if he had played a "full" career.
